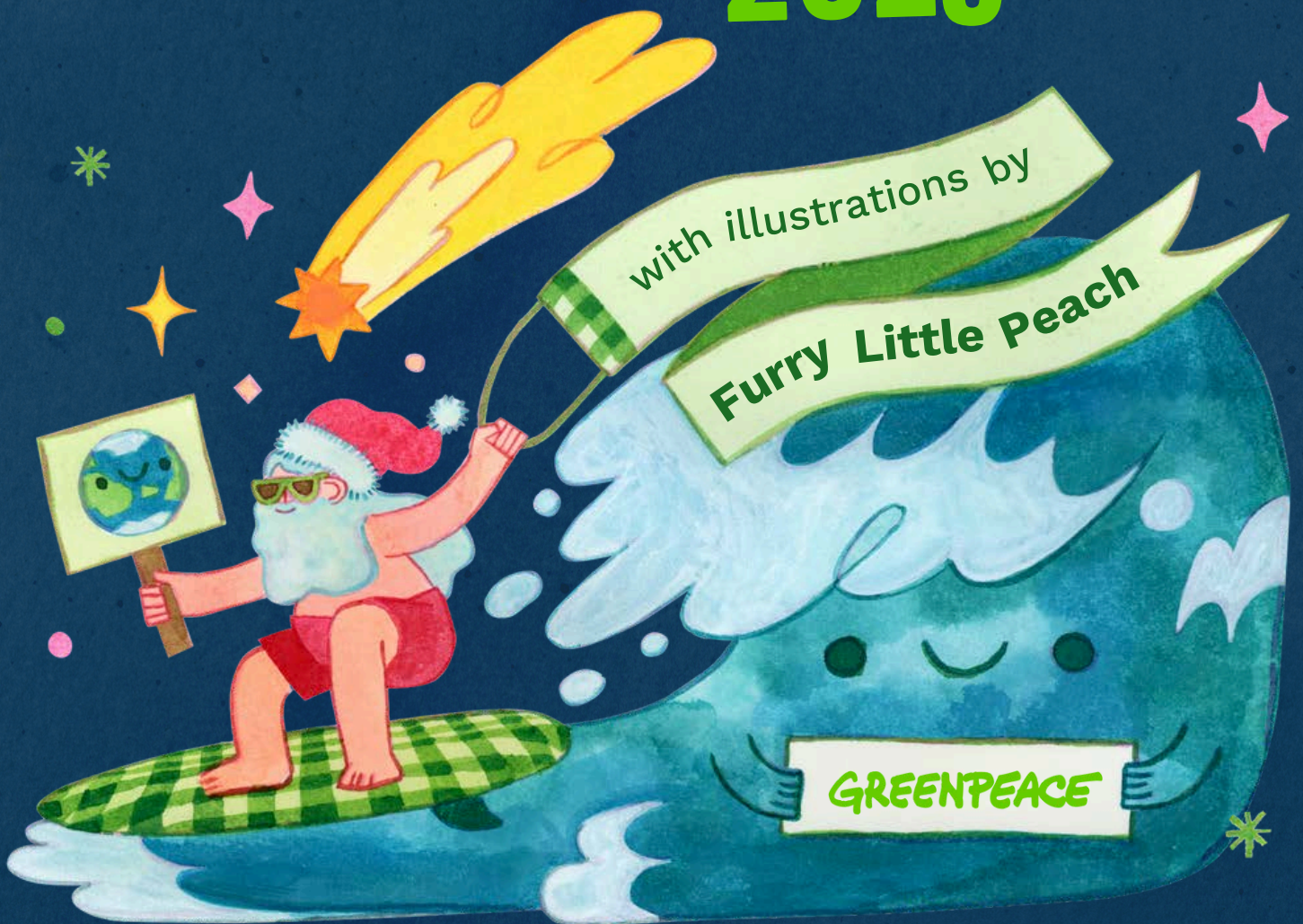

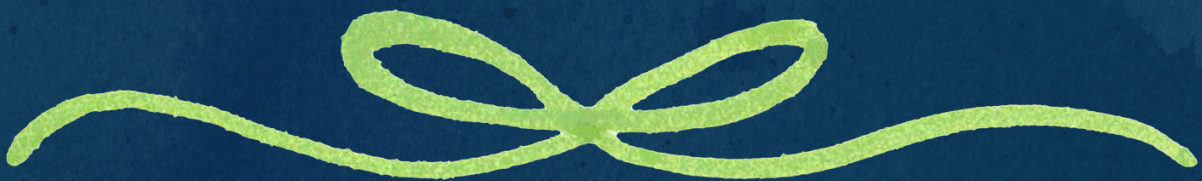

Collective Giving

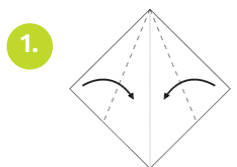
Pool small donations for Greenpeace or local environmental projects.

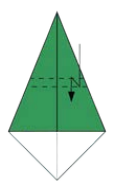


Make Your Own Origami Christmas Tree



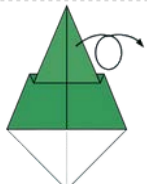
1.

Crease in half and unfold. Fold both upper edges to the vertical center



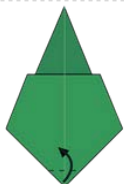
2.

Fold along the dotted line



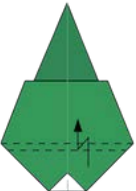
3.

Turn over



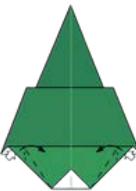
4.

Fold up the tip



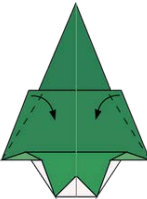
5.

Fold along the dotted line



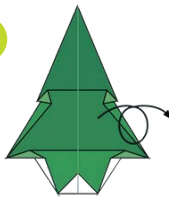
6.

Fold the bottom corners up to the centre



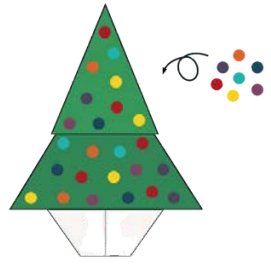
7.
